Please see the link to view a letter to all parents and carers from Dr Robyn Dewis, Director of Public Health here. In this letter, Dr Dewis outlines the current situation with Covid-19 cases in Derby and asks for the support of parents and carers in managing the current situation. Dr Dewis has asked all Derby schools to consider further measures to help reduce the current levels of Covid-19 across the city, most of which we have already implemented at Chellaston Academy. We are currently considering a change to our procedure around identification of close contacts and I will update all students, parents and carers on this at the start of next half-term, should this change. You can also find a letter from the School Age Vaccination Team, highlighting a Covid-19 'catch-up' vaccination programme for over the half-term holiday here.

Our Covid-19 preventative measures that we introduced two weeks ago have been very successful and we have seen the number of positive cases falling for all year groups. The wearing of face masks in school and on school transport will continue when students return from holiday on 1st November. Assemblies and staff meetings will also continue remotely via Microsoft Teams and we will review this approach again early next half-term. We have received a new batch of lateral flow device tests, which have been distributed to students this week. These tests are slightly different to those students have taken so far, as they require a nasal swab only.

Twice-weekly home testing will continue for the foreseeable future, including during the holiday, to help keep cases of Covid-19 down. A lateral flow test should be undertaken on the evening prior to returning to school to ensure any asymptomatic positive cases can be identified.
