Lateness to school

All students are expected to be in form at 8:30am as this is the start of the school day. If students arrive to school after this time they will be registered as late. Students who travel on a school bus will not be registered as late if the bus is delayed. In the first instance, lateness will accrue negative 10 ICE points and persistent lateness will lead to some reflection and reparation time after school. Our young people were fantastic we are so very proud of the mature and enthusiastic way that they got involved in the day. Huge thanks to the neighbourhood partnership officer, Fire service and other groups who made the event happen.
