## **Year 11 Parents Evening**

# **Change to ICE Points**

There has been a change to how ICE points are being awarded at Chellaston Academy. Every child's form tutor now awards the 18 positive points daily. This is 3 points for each of the 6 lessons during the day. Teachers, either in lessons or out of lessons, can still award extra ICE points where students demonstrate Integrity, Care and Excellence.

#### **Mock Exams**

The Year 11 Mock Exams continue next week. Well done to our Year 11s for their approach to these this week. Following the exams, teachers will be supporting the students through the post- Mock evaluation process to identify areas they can work on to improve their exam technique and revision processes to ensure success in the main exam period. Parents are strongly advised to make appointments at the upcoming parents' evening to discuss this.

As a reminder students should register with their form tutor each morning at 8.30am. Any absences should be reported in the normal way by 8am at the latest, please. Students attend exams in full school uniform and must ensure they have the correct equipment for each exam. Normal lessons will continue around the exams.

For reference, in the summer series of exams, the majority of subjects will be examined from 15<sup>th</sup> May 2023 until 28<sup>th</sup> June 2023. However, practical and language speaking tests will take place prior to this. Please avoid booking or accepting any appointments during this period.
