Summer 1	<ul> <li>Finalise photographing and paper work for submission of Controlled assessment to AQA.</li> <li>Revision booklets for section A and B will be given to students.</li> <li>MYPLC looked at to identify any further gaps in knowledge.</li> <li>Plan for revision is based on skills gaps in students' knowledge in readiness for final exam.</li> </ul>	Continually mini assessments through exam questions in lesson.  QWC looked at in depth to address this area.	Take a look at the more in depth weekly plan for revision (released nearer the time) to show which areas of knowledge will be covered. Support at home by reinforcing these areas and setting up revision timetables.
