Spring 1	 What is the water cycle? How does it work? What are the key processes rivers use to shape the land? What are key features of a river basin? How do waterfalls form? 	Literacy / peer assessment on how waterfalls form. Test on rivers and water cycle.	Use BBC Bitesize KS3/geography to know key terms / processes and features. Use class clips for video information.
Spring 2	 What are settlements? How do people decide where to live? What are the key features of Derbyshire? Using grid references. 	Literacy / peer assessment on how did people choose where to live.	Ask parents, family, friends why live where they do? Apply own experience of travel around Derbyshire – what geog features have they seen / visited.
Summer 1	 Using longitude and latitude. World Geography – oceans, mountains, and extreme environments. 	Test on settlements and map skills.	Watch news / read papers and link to where in the world major events happening. Use GEOGUESSR
Summer 2	 How to revise for geography and improve test results. Developing map skills, contour lines, height and using maps. 	End of year assessment.	Revision Techniques. Could use KS3 bitesize on BBC. Using maps on journeys to relate landscapes to maps.
