Student Survey

We have had an overwhelmingly positive response to our second student survey of the year. We are so proud of how our students are helping us to continually improve life at our academy with their honest and thoughtful feedback and our student council have also been instrumental in some of the changes we have made recently. Students can see on our screens many of the 'you said / we did' points and we will be meeting again next term to discuss how else we can work together to improve the student experience. Since the beginning of this academic year the academy has created a rigorous and robust Quality Assurance process (appreciative enquiry). We use this information to develop, improve and support all student's needs to ensure that we build this academy from the ground up. This term alone every single department has had another departmental deep dive alongside several external deep dives by the Trust which has highlighted many key strengths and areas for development.
