Safeguarding

For International Women's Day back in March, our assembly explored some of the key issues in gender stereotypes, VAWG and sexism in the media. Since then, we have done some great work with students at both an individual and group level, in conversations and pupil forums, as well as additional staff training on challenging discriminatory language.

The overwhelming feedback from students is that they feel there is a really strong message of 'empowerment', 'equality' and 'challenge' around sexism. The concerns mainly come from the influence of social media; from accounts which portray harmful notions of gender stereotypes, and from things labelled as 'humour', or bias in the media that goes unchallenged.

As always, we are grateful when parents and carers support the messages we explore in school in your own conversations at home. Below is one example of a parents' approach to harmful online content:


Reader Leader
