Afterschool detentions

This year we are running Year team afterschool detentions for those students who are repeatedly late for lesson with no reason, and for any students who truant from a lesson. These will be ran by your child's Year team and will run on a Monday from 3 until 4pm. You will be notified in advance if your child has been issued a detention for persistent lateness and or truanting from lessons.

Home Learning Timetable

From this week, we have launched our home learning timetable with the students. During the summer term, staff have been improving the quality of the tasks that are going to be set this coming year. Homework needs to be a bit like baby bear's porridge. If it's too short, it's barely worth doing, if it's too long then it starts to lose its value. Tasks should be practice or preparation type tasks and not be finishing-off

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
tasks, for example.

In order to ensure that students are not bombarded with homework on one day and then none the next, staff have been given days that subjects can set homework. Sometimes, there might not be a lesson on that day, so home learning will be set in advance for that day. As home learning is such an important factor in increasing levels of success at exams, staff can reward students with +10 points for every task. Staff can also notify parents through Go4schools if tasks haven't been completed, but this is just a notification and does not incur any negative points.

We believe that home learning should allow practice of skills, prepare students for future lessons and exams. It should help build independent learning skills, develop self-regulation and organisation and train them to make use of resources outside of school. We hope that the planning that we have put in place will help to achieve these goals.

Parents also play a part in this process, so please use the Firefly platform to check when students have been set tasks.
