Internal changes to the school day - 7th May

At the moment, Year 11 and Year 13 are attending after-school revision classes in preparation for their forthcoming exams. The examinations start in May and the afternoon exams start at 1pm, which is the same time as we have our dinner. To reduce the risk of disrupting the examinations with unnecessary noise, we are changing the school day from Tuesday May 7th. This involves switching around period 4 and dinnertime.

Dinnertime - 12:20pm-1pm (An hour earlier than at the moment) **Period 4** - 1pm-2pm

Period 5 - 2pm-3pm

This will continue to the end of June until the main examinations and Y10/Y12 mocks have completed.

Year 11 and Year 13 - Last full days of teaching

Year 11 - Most Year 11 students have got almost 20 examinations to take in a four-week period. Year 11 students attend school as normal until Friday June 7th. After this date, they still have at least four exams, but they can just turn up for their exams and then leave the site. (In full uniform). Revision sessions will be also put in place in the week of June 10-14th for the remaining subjects.

Year 13 - Pre-covid, the vast majority of the Year 13 exams took place after May half-term. This year has seen exams getting earlier and earlier. The last full teaching day for Year 13 will be Wednesday 15th May. Before this day, there is likely to be some additional sessions put on for subjects that have exams Monday 13th-15th.


Easter Recital Evening - 18th March


