

Pupils also know that the high expectations that staff have help them to achieve academically and personally.

The school's ICE (integrity, care and excellence) values permeate the school's work. Staff focus on helping pupils improve their mindsets. This builds pupils' strength of character.

Pupils feel safe and happy at the school.

Pupils' overwhelming view is the school does not tolerate poor behaviour and that staff will deal with it if it does occur.





Most parents and carers would recommend this school to others. One parent comment that summed up the view of many was, 'My daughter has really flourished while being at Chellaston. She has improved academically as well as becoming more confident.'

The school has devised a curriculum that is both broad and ambitious. There are high academic expectations for pupils. Many pupils have the chance to study two languages in key stage 3. Pupils benefit from this approach and receive a well-rounded high-quality education.

Leaders have increased capacity to ensure that skilled staff identify and meet pupils' learning needs. This includes the school's 'inclusion graduated response' for those pupils who struggle in school. Pupils benefit from the schools 'connect' provision.

There is an effective strategy to support pupils who need help to become better readers. Skilled reading specialists intervene to help these pupils get better at reading.







Get to know your Child's Form Tutor








Uniform Expectations

Punctuality

We believe that good punctuality is essential to maximise employment chances when students leave school

Please refrain from dropping your child off on the school site.









- Menus are reviewed regularly






Parent Contact/Portal


